Type	Government of Alberta Health Care Aide Certificate (Students cannot graduate from the program until they have passed the provincial certification exam)
Program Delivery	Hybrid Online theory classes and in-person lab classes

Program Entry Requirements

Eligibility for the program can be established through either Standard Admission or Mature Admission, with further details provided below. Students can choose to begin their application online or in-person and must pay the application fee before their submission will be processed.

1. Standard Admission

Academic English Language Arts (ELA)

- English 20-1 or 20-2 with a minimum score of 60% achieved or Canadian jurisdiction equivalent, or
- English 30-1 or 30-2 with a minimum of 55% or Canadian jurisdiction equivalent

2. Mature Student Admission

- Must be 19 years of age or older
- Out of high school for 1 year
- Successfully meet the entry levels on Columbia College's Accuplacer assessment test or show academic levels needed for our College Preparation Courses.

*Please note that for those who English is not their first language, a minimum benchmark of CLB 7 is recommended. Academic and admission requirements would also still need to be met.

Additional Requirements

- Attend Columbia College's Orientation prior to the start of the program
- Admissions interview(s) to determine suitability for the profession and opportunity for success in the program
- Up-to-date immunization record
- Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Search
