### Prerequsities

To enroll in the course, individuals must meet the following criteria:

- At least 18 years old
- Completed the Alberta Basic Security Training (ABST)
   Course (for the in-classroom course delivery only)
- Fluent in speaking English (Level 5 Canadian Language Benchmark)
- No serious criminal convictions that have not been pardoned

# License Requirements

After successfully passing the provincial exam and receiving your certificate, you must apply for your licensing at an approved Registry Office or the Solicitor General's Office. To be eligible, you must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be at least 18 years old at the time of registration.
- 2. Fluent in English (CLB score of 5 or higher).
- 3. Submit a current Police Information Check, including a Vulnerable Sector Search, with no serious convictions.

  Include a signed passport-sized photo provided by the police.
- 4. Pass the Alberta Investigator Training Exam with a minimum score of 80%.
- 5. Be eligible to work in Canada as a Canadian citizen, Landed Immigrant, Permanent Resident, or hold a valid Work Visa.
